## ABOUT FAYETTEVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

Widely recognized as one of the leading high schools in the state and region, Fayetteville High School is a public, four-year high school with an average enrollment of 2,500. Located next door to the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville High School boasts an architecturally award-winning campus, renovated and expanded over five years, completed in 2015. Phases of the 565,000 square foot facility are certified both LEED Silver and LEED Gold. There are 216 certified faculty members, and 50 classified staff members.

Well-rounded Fayetteville High School students excel in academics, fine arts and athletics. Ninety percent of 2017 graduates attended either a two-year or four-year college. FHS annually produces more AP Scholars than any other school in Arkansas – 67 percent of FHS students took an AP class in 2017.

In 2017, FHS athletes won state championships in girls basketball, dance, football, boys golf, girls track and volleyball. The school offers extraordinary and award-winning programs in band, choir, theater, orchestra, and the visual arts, as well as a vibrant career and technical education program.

The hashtag #fhsfamily, developed and used by FHS students, underscores the culture inspired by this close knit circle of students, educators, staff members, administrators, parents, community members, and friends.

The Fayetteville School District was the first school district granted a charter by the State of Arkansas in 1871. The district was also the first to voluntarily integrate its schools, only five days after the *Brown v. Board of Education* decision in 1954. With one high school, two junior highs, two middle schools, one combined middle and elementary school, 8 elementary schools, one virtual academy and one alternative learning environment, Fayetteville Public Schools serves nearly 10,000 students every day.
